Re-Opening of College for the 1st; 3rd and 4th year students

This is to inform all the students of I, III and IV years that, the offline examinations/Lab sessions (Academic Year 2020-2021) which are pending will be resumed from July 5, 2021 (Monday) onwards. During this period, Offline examinations/Lab sessions will be conducted. The students are requested to strictly adhere to the following guidelines to ensure their safety along with peer group. The detailed time tables for the sessional examinations; Laboratory sessions and Semester end examinations will be issued by the respective departments.

General Instruction

- The students shall strictly wear the Face mask, Face shield and carry their own Hand Sanitizers at all times during their movement on campus
- Students shall install the "Arogya Setu" in their mobile phones to ensure their health and safety
- Students are advised to bring their own water bottles & lunch and suggested to not to share among their peer group
- Day scholars while commuting by bus, are instructed to take maximum precaution to ensure their safety by taking appropriate measures and maintaining social distance
- Thermal scanning will be done at the college gate and entry of college buses. Students reported with high temperature will not be allowed into the campus
- Gathering of students inside the campus before and after the classwork/examination is strictly prohibited
- All the Day scholars &Hostellers shall produce the RT-PCR —Ve report at the college gate which is taken 72hrs before reporting to the campus i.e not earlier than July 3, 2021
- Students are advised to get Vaccinated preferably before they report to the college
- Students submitting fake certificates with regard to RT- PCR and vaccination certification will be seriously viewed and penalized
- In view of the lockdown timings Students are advised to plan their travel so that they report to the hostels between 6 AM to 7.00PM on 4th, 5th and 6th July 2021
- In case of students who could not appear for the offline exams during this period due to COVID +ve
 report, as per the protocol a special exam will be conducted at a later date subject to the submission
 of the reports
- Examination seating arrangements will be done separately for day scholars and hostellers.
- The movement of the Hostellers and day scholars are restricted and are not allowed to mingle on the campus
- All the operations are carried out with 50% occupancy on the campus
- All the GMRIT staff are 100% vaccinated and hence they are safe and secured

Note: Students other than the regular hostellers and College bus users willing to have the temporary hostel accommodation and bus service are requested to fill the google form floated in the given link. Hostel fee of Rs 5000/-will be charged for 3rd year students for two weeks stay and Rs 10,000 /- will be charged for 1st year students for their four weeks of stay. Further, the students are requested to remit the required fee for the above on or before July 5, 2021.
