

CIRCULAR

Re-Opening of Hostels with COVID Protocol

This is to inform all the students that, the offline examinations/Lab sessions which are pending have resumed from July 5, 2021 (Monday) onwards. The hostel students are requested to strictly adhere to the following guidelines to ensure their safety along with peer group.

General Instruction

- The students shall strictly wear the Face mask, Face shield and carry their own Hand Sanitizers at all times during their movement on campus and hostels
- Students shall install the "Arogya Setu" in their mobile phones to ensure their health and safety
- Students are advised to bring their own water bottles & suggested to not to share among their peer group
- All the Hostellers shall remain and stay back in their own rooms if they don't have any class work or examination
- Hostellers will be allowed to move out of the hostels just half an hour before the commencement of the classwork/examination and shall report back to the hostel rooms within half an hour after the completion of the classwork/examinations.
- Hostel Staff and campus security shall ensure that all the hostellers follow the guideline
- To avoid overcrowding and to maintain social distancing, different time slots are fixed for dining hall. Students are advised strictly to follow the dining hall timing and get back to the rooms immediately after taking the food.
- Gathering of students inside the hostel campus before and after the classwork or examination is strictly prohibited
- All the Hostellers shall produce the RT-PCR -Ve report at the college gate which is taken 72hrs before reporting to the campus
- Students are advised to get Vaccinated preferably before they report to the college/hostel
- Students submitting fake certificates with regard to RT-PCR and vaccination certification will be seriously viewed and penalized
- In view of the lockdown timings Students are advised to plan their travel so that they report to the hostels between 6 AM to 7.00PM
- In case of students who could not appear for the offline exams due to COVID +ve report, as per the protocol they will be given opportunity to take the exam again and will be conducted along with the supply exams scheduled subsequently
- Examination seating arrangements will be done separately for day scholars and hostellers.
- The movement of the Hostellers and day scholars are restricted and are not allowed to mingle on the campus
- All the operations are carried out with 50% occupancy on the campus
- All the GMRIT staff are 100% vaccinated and hence they are safe and secured
